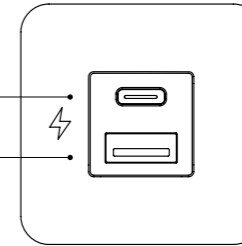

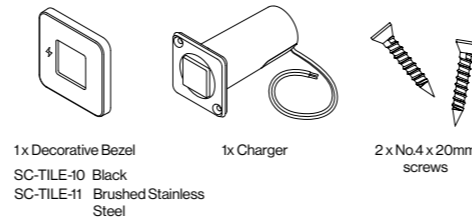

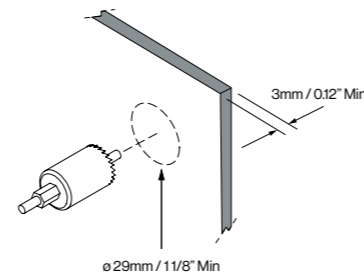
1x Decorative Bezel

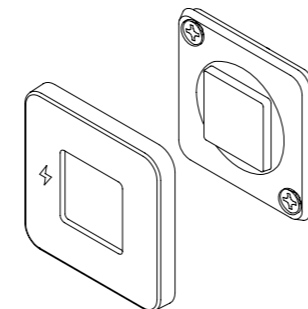
2x No.4 x 20mm screws

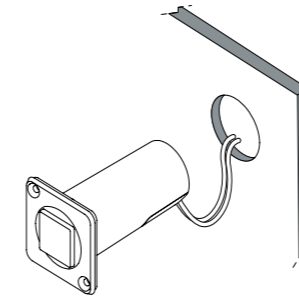
1 Drill mounting hole using hole saw



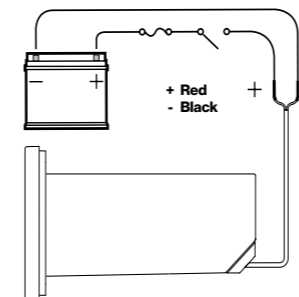
4 Clip bezel over charger



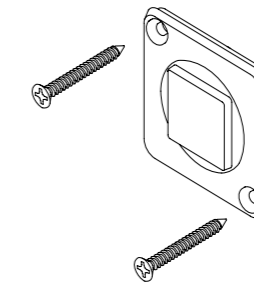
2 Connect to wiring loom pre or post panel mounting



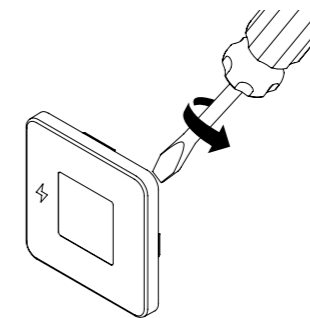
5 Connect to 12/24V supply, ensuring a waterproof connection. Fuse and select cable diameter according to input voltage and current for your specific installation.



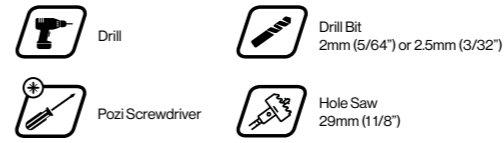
3 Drill Pilot hole suitable for substrate and fix it in place
